



# 2025 WEDNESDAY MIXED ADULT COMPETITION

Welcome to Noosa's Mixed Netball Competition.  
The competition is open to all players 15 years of age and older.

## COMPETITION FORMAT

<b>Length of Competition</b>	10 weeks										
<b>Team Nominations due</b>	Wednesday 12 <sup>th</sup> February 2025										
<b>Player Registrations due</b>	Wednesday 26 <sup>th</sup> February 2025										
<b>Time slots</b>	6.30pm and 7.30pm										
<b>Comp start date</b>	Wednesday 5 <sup>th</sup> March 2025										
<b>Competition Format</b>	<p>Fixture games are 4 x 12-minute quarters. No finals will be played. The winner will be the team with the most points at the conclusion of the 10-week competition. If points are equal, the winner will be decided by goals for and against.</p> <p>Points will be awarded as follows:</p> <table style="margin-left: 20px;"> <tr> <td>1. <b>WIN</b></td> <td><b>2 POINTS</b></td> </tr> <tr> <td>2. <b>DRAW</b></td> <td><b>1 POINT</b></td> </tr> <tr> <td>3. <b>LOSS</b></td> <td><b>0 POINTS</b></td> </tr> <tr> <td>4. <b>FORFEIT (team forfeiting)</b></td> <td><b>0 POINTS</b></td> </tr> <tr> <td>5. <b>FORFEIT (team not forfeiting)</b></td> <td><b>2 POINTS</b></td> </tr> </table> <p>Only the winning team will receive an award.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rolling substitutions permitted.</li> <li>• If a team has less than 7 players for a game, they may borrow from another team</li> <li>• Only registered players in this competition can be borrowed.</li> <li>• You can only borrow an individual player once per season.</li> <li>• Male/female ratio and court positions must still be maintained.</li> <li>• The borrowed player must sign the scoresheet and indicate which team they are from</li> <li>• One male must always be on the court and the maximum number of males allowed on the court is three. Male players must be in three different positions on the court (Defending, Centre Positions and Attacking Positions):             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Goal Keeper or Goal Defence (Defending Positions).</li> <li>2. Wing Attack, Wing Defence or Centre (Centre Positions).</li> <li>3. <b>Wet Weather Games</b>	Games cancelled due to wet weather will be replayed the following Wednesday immediately at the conclusion of that week's fixture games. All games (including the regular fixture games set down for that date) will consist of 2 x 12-minute halves.										

## GAME DAY

<b>Scoring</b>	All games will either be live scored via Netball Connect, by the nominated Team Scorer or paper scoring. Paper scoresheets will be available from the office
<b>Umpiring</b>	Umpires will be allocated by the Association for the 10-week competition. All teams must nominate a capable team umpire. Team umpires will only be used if an appointed umpire is unable to fulfil their allocation.
<b>Canteen</b>	Canteen will be unavailable for this competition.
<b>Grounds duty</b>	6.30pm game - teams are asked to collect post pads for their court. 7.30pm game - team are asked to remove post protectors and take to shed.

No other refunds will be considered</li> </ul>

<b>Scratch Matches</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In the case of a team who advised their intention to forfeit a game for a specific round and the game is subsequently postponed due to wet weather, then the notice of intention to forfeit will no longer be valid. Such teams will be eligible to play in the rescheduled match.</li> <li>• In the event of a forfeit, please ensure that you advise us asp either by phone on 0438 638 899 (preferred) or via email on noosanetball@gmail.com</li> <li>• Teams are encouraged to play a scratch match in the event of a forfeit. If a scratch match is played, then the team that has forfeited receives no points nor will they be credited with any goals scored. The forfeit fine is waived in this instance.</li> <li>• The team that is requesting the scratch match must have at least 3 registered players from that team available to take the court.</li> <li>• The team that is receiving the forfeit cannot refuse to play a scratch match.</li> </ul>

<b>Player Registrations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Player registrations are completed individually by each player, online via the Netball Connect app or online at: <a href="https://www.noosanetballassociation.com/register-here">https://www.noosanetballassociation.com/register-here</a></li> <li>Teams must have at least 7 players registered before competition starts.</li> <li>Players <b>MUST</b> be registered before taking to the court</li> </ul>
