| Competition Format | Fixture games are 4 x 12-minute quarters. No finals will be played. The winner will be the team with the most points at the conclusion of the 10-week competition. If points are equal, the winner will be decided by goals for and against. | |

| | 1.WIN2 POINTS2.DRAW1 POINT3.LOSS0 POINTS4.FORFEIT (team forfeiting)0 POINTS5.FORFEIT (team not forfeiting)2 POINTSOnly the winning team will receive an award. | |
| | Rolling substitutions permitted. | |
| | If a team has less than 7 players for a game, they may borrow from another team | |
| | Only registered players in this competition can be borrowed. | |
| | • You can only borrow an individual player once per season. | |
| | Male/female ratio and court positions must still be maintained. | |
| | The borrowed player must sign the scoresheet and indicate which team they are from | |
| | One male must always be on the court and the maximum number of males allowed on the court is three. Male players must be in three different positions on the court (Defending, Centre Positions and Attacking Positions): | |
| | Goal Keeper or Goal Defence (Defending Positions). Wing Attack, Wing Defence or Centre (Centre Positions). Goal Attack or Goal Shooter (Attacking Positions). | |
| Wet Weather Games | Games cancelled due to wet weather will be replayed the following Wednesday immediately at the conclusion of that week's fixture games. All games (including the regular fixture games set down for that date) will consist of 2 x 12-minute halves. | |

| Scoring | All games will either be live scored via Netball Connect, by the nominated Team Scorer or paper scoring. Paper scoresheets will be available from the office |
